Where: Mercure Letchworth Hotel, Letchworth Lane, Letchworth Garden City, SG6 3NP

Parking is available but limited, so walkers are encouraged to car share where possible. If you live locally, we recommend walking to the start (and getting a few extra steps in!).



17.00: Registration opens in the Arlington Suite, next to the car park, where our volunteers will check you in. You will receive an event wristband which must be worn throughout your walk. Toilets are available inside the hotel.

Before the walk: There's a real buzz about the registration area prior to the walk starting, with opportunities to fill out an inspiration heart, take part in our raffle, get your face painted and buy branded merchandise. A 'Really Awesome Coffee' van will also be available.









18.30: The walk starts... good luck and most importantly, have fun! Friends, family and colleagues are invited sign up on the day should they wish to join you, and dogs are also welcome to take part!

During the walk: Portaloos will be available for your use half way at Hitchin Garden Centre, and the coffee van will also reappear. Snacks and dog treat stations are also available throughout the route.

21.30: You must aim to be finished by this time. A complementary glass of fizz or juice and a hot snack will await you at the hotel, and the bar will be open should you wish to "cheers" the day with your loved ones!
